Infection

Notify our office immediately if you develop any of the following signs of a possible joint infection:

- Persistent fever (higher than 101.5°F orally)
- Shaking chills
- Increasing redness, tenderness, or swelling of your surgical incision
- Drainage from the wound
- Significant increase in pain with both activity and rest
